RENTAL OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

Unified School District 501 is a public quasi-municipal corporation operated for the general welfare of the community with the responsibility for providing elementary and secondary education. In working toward the realization of that mission, the Board of Education has established the following guidelines for the use of district facilities by the community.

- I. The primary use of facilities, equipment, material, and personnel shall be reserved for the provision of educational opportunities for children and youth of eligible school age in the district.
- II. Extended educational opportunities, both preschool and posthigh school, shall be provided the community to the extent that finances will permit or programs can be self-supporting.
- III. School facilities shall be made available to local educational, religious, and recreational organizations when such is in the best interest of the community and can be made available.
- IV. The nature of the group--its purpose and its proposed use of the facility--shall determine the conditions of use.

The Board of Education expects those using district facilities to defray the cost of operation as well as any damages that result from that use. An additional charge shall be assessed when firemen, policemen, and/or security officers are required to be on duty.
